

#### 1. Background

The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises issued a notification dated 26<sup>th</sup> June 2020 regarding revision of definition of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) and process of registration. Apart from the old criteria of categorization of MSMEs on the basis of investment in Plant and Machinery/Equipment, an additional criterion of turnover has been included. Moreover, the difference between manufacturing and services sector has been removed and now both are at the same level of treatment. This revision is paving the way for strengthening of AtmanirbharBharatAbhiyanand growth of the MSMEs. Particularly, the provision of excluding the exports from counting of turnover is encouraging the MSMEs to export more and more without fearing to forego the benefits of being an MSME.

As a result of change in classification criteria w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020, an Enterprises is being classified as a Micro, Small or Medium Enterprises on the basis of the following criteria, namely:-

- a) Micro Enterprises: where the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed one crore rupees and turnover does not exceed five crore rupees;
- b) Small Enterprises: where the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed ten crore rupees and turnover does not exceed fifty crore rupees; and
- c) **Medium Enterprises:** where the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed **fifty crore rupees** and turnover does not exceed **two hundred and fifty crore rupees**.



Ministry of MSME launched a portal-Udyam Registration Portal (<u>https://udyamregistration.gov.in</u>) on 1st July 2020.

Key features of the portal are as under: -

- It is a unified portal with registration process free of cost, paperless and digital.
- The portal is aimed at reducing transaction time and cost for entrepreneurs and promotes Ease of Doing Business.
- The new MSME registration process is simple, seamless and entrepreneur friendly.
- All the relevant data is being fetched from Income Tax and GST Networks at the backend.
- Udyam Registration is mandatory to avail benefits under most of the schemes of Ministry of MSME and availing credit from financial institutions as per RBI notification no. RBI/2020-2021/26 dated 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2020. (https://www.rbi.org.in/Scripts/BS\_CircularIndexDisplay.aspx?Id=11951)
- M/o MSME has also commenced API integration of Udyam Registration portal with GeM so that MSEs can participate in Government procurement easily.

# M/o MSME issued a notification on 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 for certain amendments in the earlier notification dated 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2020. The amendments made are as follows:-

- 1. The exemption from the requirement of having GSTIN shall be as per the provisions of the Central Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 (12 of 2017).
- 2. In case of any proprietorship Enterprises not registered under any Act or rules of the Central Government or the State Government, the proprietor may use his or her PAN for registration of the Enterprises in the Udyam Registration portal and for all other types of Enterprises PAN shall be mandatory.

## Addition of Activities (NIC code) under MSMED Act, 2006 for Udyam Registration - Retail and Wholesale Trade

Now, Retail and wholesale trades are allowed to be registered on Udyam Registration Portal as MSMEs. However, benefits to Retail and Wholesale trade MSMEs are to be restricted to Priority Sector Lending only.

The list of eligible additional activities is as under:

45	Wholesale and retail trade and repair of motor vehicle and motorcycles
46	Wholesale trade except of motor vehicles and motor cycles
47	Retail Trade Except of Motor Vehicles and motor cycles

#### Highlights of the Udyam Registration process are as under:

- Aadhaar/PAN is required for registration;
- After completion of the process of registration, an Udyam Registration Certificate will be issued;
- This certificate will have a dynamic QR Code from which the web page on Udyam Registration Portal and details about the Enterprises can be accessed;
- There will be no need for renewal of Registration;
- PAN & GST linked details on investment and turnover of Enterprises will be taken automatically from the respective Government databases;
- No Enterprises is supposed to file more than one Udyam Registration. However, any number of activities including manufacturing or services, or both, may be specified or added in one Registration.

### Government's Facilitation mechanism –68 State Champions Control Rooms, Field Institutions/Offices of Ministry of MSME and DICs;

Upto 30th June 2021, 35,29,084 MSMEs were registered on Udyam Registration portal comprising of 32,79,370 Micro (93%); 2,21,641 Small (6%) and 28,073 Medium (1%) Enterprises.

### 2. Distribution of MSMEs

**35,29,084 number of MSMEs were registered on Udyam Registration portal, till 30.06.2021**,comprising of 32,79,370 Micro (93%); 2,21,641 Small (6%) and 28,073 Medium Enterprises (1%).





Figure 1: Distribution of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises

### 3. Distribution of MSMEs-(Top 10 States/U.Ts)

**Maharashtra has the highest number of MSMEs** with a share of **22.3%**, followed by Tamil Nadu (10.8%), Gujarat (9.1%), Rajasthan (8.3%), and Uttar Pradesh (7.7%).





The graph below shows top 10 states/UTs having Udyam registration as **Micro Enterprises**. It can be observed that **Maharashtra has the highest number of Micro Enterprises** with a share of **22.8%**, followed by Tamil Nadu (10.9%), Gujarat (8.8%), Rajasthan (8.5%) and Uttar Pradesh (7.8%).




Figure 3: Distribution of Micro Enterprises: Top 10 States/U.T.s




Figure 4: Distribution of Small Enterprises: Top 10 States/U.T.s

The above graph shows top 10 states/UTs for **Small Enterprises**. It can be observed that **Maharashtra has the highest number of Small Enterprises** with a share of **16.4%.** The rest of the states are Gujarat (13.1%), Tamil Nadu (9.8%), Rajasthan (6.6%), Delhi (6.1%) and Karnataka (5.7%).





Figure 5: Distribution of Medium Enterprises: Top 10 States/U.T.s





Figure 7: Distribution of MSMEs: Eastern Region

#### **Western Region**





Figure 9: Distribution of MSMEs: Western Region

#### **North Eastern Region**




Figure 11: Distribution of MSMEs: NER Region

Figure 12 showcases top 10 districts for registration of MSMEs in Udyam Registration portal. As it can be seen among the top 10 districts that in Pune there are maximum no. of MSMEs. In the top 10 districts list, four districts are from Maharashtra, two districts each from Gujarat & Tamil Nadu, one each from Karnataka and Rajasthan.




Figure 13: District wise distribution of Micro Enterprises: Top 10 Districts

In the country, the highest registrations of Micro Enterprises are from Pune (3.5%), Thane (2.7%), Jaipur (2.2%) followed by Mumbai suburban (2.1%), Ahmedabad (2.1%) etc.




Figure 14: District wise distribution of Small Enterprises: Top 10 Districts

The highest number of Small Enterprises registrations are from Mumbai district (3.3%) followed by Surat (3.2%), Bengaluru (Urban) (3.5%), Ahmedabad (3.2%) and Pune (2.8%)Bengaluru(Urban) – 5.1%, followed by Pune (4.9%), Mumbai (4.1%), Chennai (4%) etc.





Figure 15: District wise distribution of Medium Enterprises :Top 10 Districts

The top 10 districts having **Medium Enterprise** registrations are indicated in the above graph. It can be observed that the highest number of Medium enterprises are registered in **Mumbai district (5.7%),**followed by Bengalauru (Urban) (3.8%), Ahmedabad (3.5%), Kolkata (2.9%), Mumbai Suburban (2.9%) and Pune (2.9%)etc.

The above graph (figure 16) indicates **top 10 Aspirational districts** in terms of Udyam registration of MSMEs. **Jalgaon district in Maharasthtra has the highest number of MSME registration**, followed by Ranchi, Visakhapatnam, Virudhnagar East Singhbhum, Muzaffarpur, Osmanabad, Bokarao, Haridwar and Udham Singh Nagar.

### 7. State wise Employment




Figure 17: Top 10 States/UTs with highest number of Employment and Average Employment per firm: All MSMEs

Above graph showcases top 10 States/UTs with highest number of employment and the average employment per MSMEs. It can be seen that even though Maharashtra has highest employment among MSMEs, but the average employment per firm is 7, however in Telanagana and Karnataka, the average employment per enterprise is 16 and 13 respectively. The average employment per enterprise in top 10 states/UT is 12.




Figure 18: Top 10 States/UTs with highest number of Employment and Average Employment per firm: Micro Enterprises

Above graph showcases top 10 States/UTs with highest number of employment and the average employment per Micro Enterprise. It can be seen that **Maharashtra has highest employment among Micro enterprises**, the average employment per firm is 5, however in Telangana and West Bengal, the average employment per enterprise is13 and 10 respectively. **The average employment per Micro enterprise in top 10 states/UT is 7.** 




Figure 19: Top 10 States/UTs with highest number of Employment and Average Employment per firm: Small Enterprises

The state wise distribution of employment in Small Enterprises among the top 10 States/UTs are highlighted above with Maharashtra generating the highest employment and the average employment per Small enterprise is varying from 22 to 47 persons. The average employment per Small enterprise in top 10 states/UT is 37.




Figure 20: Top 10 States/UTs with highest number of Employment and Average Employment per firm: Medium Enterprises

The above graph (figure 20) indicates the state wise distribution of employment in Medium Enterprises among the top 10 States/UTs. It can be observed that Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu and Gujarat have the highest employment in Medium Enterprises. The average employment per Medium enterprise in top 10 states/UT is 171.

#### 8. Gender wise distribution

The graph below highlights the percentage distribution of MSMEs on the basis of **Gender ownership**. **Male owned MSMEs constitute 81%**, whereas 17% of MSMEs are owned by female. The rest share (1% each) is constituted by other and unidentified firms.




Figure 21: Gender wise distribution of MSMEs

#### 9. Social Category wise distribution




Figure 22 Social category wise distribution

Figure 22 shows (below) percentage distribution of MSMEs owned by various **Social** categories. General owned enterprises constitutes 63%, OBCs own 28%, followed by SCs with 6% ownership and STs with 2%. 1% of the MSMEs are in unidentified category.

A total of 2301 MSMEs are owned by **Divyangjan entrepreneurs**. The graph below highlights the distribution of MSMEs among them.




Figure 23: MSMEs owned by Divyangjan




Figure 24: Type of Companies by nature of business




Figure 28: Top 5 NIC code distribution of MSMEs





Figure 29 Top 5 NIC distribution of MSMEs: SC ownership




