#### A. Overview of World IP Day Programme by Ministry of MSME

The World IP Day 2023 was celebrated across 13 cities in the country by the Ministry of Micro Small & Medium Enterprises. The subject programmes were organized to mark the Day seeks to inform about the role of Intellectual Property Rights in encouraging innovation and creativity in MSMEs.

#### **B.** About World IP Day

In 2000, WIPO's member states designated April 26 – the day on which the WIPO Convention came into force in 1970 – as World IP Day, with the aim of increasing general awareness and understanding of IP. World IP Day offers a unique opportunity to join with others around the globe to consider how intellectual property (IP) helps the international ecosystem across industries to flourish and enables the technological innovation that drives human progress.

World IP Day is an opportunity to highlight the role that IP rights, such as, patents, trademarks, industrial designs, copyright), play in encouraging innovation and creativity. A balanced IP system recognizes and rewards inventors and creators for their work and ensures that society benefits from their creativity and ingenuity.

#### Theme for 2023

The theme of World Intellectual Property 2023 was "Women and IP: Accelerating Innovation and Creativity". Women make up nearly half of the global population (49.58%) and represent a huge pool of talent, which remains largely untapped. 2023 World IP Day celebrated the "can do" attitude of women inventors, creators and entrepreneurs around the world and their ground-breaking work.

#### C. Highlights from the event - World IP Day

- The event was organized across 13 cities in the country.
- The event was attended by more than 1300 participants across all locations.
- The event saw participation from **more than 50 experts**, these included Lawyers, academia's and professionals in the field of IPR and relevant fields.



- **Multiple panel discussion, expert lectures,** success stories presentation, quizzes were conducted during the course of the events.
- Overview of Ministry of MSME schemes with special emphasis on MSME Innovative scheme was also provided during the events.

#### D. About MSME Innovative Scheme

#### **Objective**

- ❖ To promote all forms of innovations in the complete value chain from developing ideas into innovative applications through incubation and design interventions.
- ❖ To provide appropriate facilities and support for development of concept to market, design competitiveness and protection& commercialization of Intellectual creations of MSME sector.
- ❖ To promote a culture of innovation and creative problem solving through knowledge sharing and collaboration amongst industry, academia, government institutions, research laboratories etc.
- To serve as a connecting link between industrial/academia leaders and innovators, in order to encourage new product development and hand-holding.
- ❖ To focus on developing affordable innovations that can benefit a large number of people and at the same time being commercially viable and sustainable.

#### **Key benefits**

#### Incubation:

- Financial Assistance to HI for developing and nurturing the ideas shall be provided up to maximum of Rs. 15lakh per idea to HI.
- Financial assistance for Plant and Machinery to HI up to Rs. 1.00 cr. (max) shall be provided for procurement and installation of relevant plant and machines including hardware and software etc. in BI for R&D activities and common facilities for incubatees of BI.

#### Design

- Design Project: For the design projects approved for any MSME, 75% (Micro) and 60% (Small & Medium) of the total project cost will be contributed by Government of India up to maximum of Rs. 40 lakhs and the remaining project cost will be borne by MSMEs and deposited to the Implementing Agencies.
- Student Project: 75% of the total project costs will be contributed by Government of India up to a maximum of Rs. 2.5 lakhs.

#### **IPR**

- A Grant of up to Rs. 1 crore would be provided to an IP Facilitation Centre in milestonebased (three or more) installments.
- Reimbursement for registration of Patent, Trademark, Geographical Indications (G.I.), Design: The maximum financial assistance to the eligible applicants under the IPR component is as follows:

3	GI Registration	Rs. 2.00 lakhs

#### **Scheme Applicable for**

- ✓ **Incubation**: MSMEs, Individuals, Students who want to develop their innovative ideas can apply through registered HIs.
- ✓ **Design**: The beneficiary unit(s) must typically be a registered micro, small or medium enterprises as per the definition in MSMED Act and should have a valid UAM or Udyam Registration.
- ✓ **IPR**: For Manufacturing MSMEs with UAM/UDYAM Registration.
